1) CALL TO ORDER AND ESTABLISH QUORUM

Mayor Branigan called the meeting to order at 5:22 PM.

Council Member Crossland gave the invocation. The pledges to the US and Texas flags were led by Mayor Branigan.

2) REGULAR AGENDA

a) Discussion, Review of and possible action regarding proposed Resolution 2023-R-014 to authorize city staff to submit an application to Williamson County regarding the City of Liberty Hill's proposed projects regarding a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). (P. Brandenburg)

Paul Brandenburg, City Administrator introduced the item and presented the staff report. He explained that since the deadline to submit this application falls before their next Regular City Council meeting (April 12, 2023), staff suggested this quick special meeting to allow for them to review this Resolution and ask any questions that they might still have regarding the proposed grant application.

If approved by the City Council tonight, Resolution #2023-R-014 will be forwarded tomorrow to Judy Langford with the Langford and Associates, our grant consultants. She will immediately submit the request.

There was a brief discussion regarding the sidewalks (Shared Use Paths) being a benefit to a cross section of citizens, walkers, bikers, downtown shoppers, and children walking to school. The project may have to be done in phases depending on funding.

The council reviewed the information in their agenda packets including a map of the proposed sidewalks, and estimated costs.

Motion:

Motion to approve, as presented, proposed Resolution 2023-R-014 to authorize city staff to submit an application to Williamson County regarding the City of Liberty Hill's proposed projects regarding a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). Motion by Council Member Jones, seconded by Council Member Crossland. Motion carried unanimously with a 4-0 vote. Ayes: Jones, Crossland, Young and Mancilla. Nays: None. Abstentions: None. With Council Member Pezold absent.
