

ELECTION NOTICES

CITY OF LIBERTY HILL, TEXAS

The next General Election in the City of Liberty Hill will be held Saturday – May 2, 2020. This year MAYOR, ALDERMAN PLACE 2 and ALDERMAN PLACE 4 will be running for re-election to serve at-large (not geographically based), two-year terms. The terms of office will be May 2020 to May 2023.

Election Day

Saturday, May 2, 2020 – 7 AM to 7 PM
Liberty Hill High School – Highway 29

Terms

Council members are elected "at-large" each representing the entire community and each serving two-year terms.

MAYOR, ALDERMAN PLACE 2 and ALDERMAN PLACE 4 are up for re-election in the May 2020 General Election.

ALDERMAN PLACE 1; PLACE 3 and PLACE 5 will be up for re-election in the May 2021 General Election.

Qualifications

Qualifications - Eligibility of Office

- All candidates for office must be citizens of the United States
- Must have lived in the state for a minimum of one year prior to the filing deadline
- Must be a resident of the City of Liberty Hill for six months prior to the filing deadline
- Must be a registered voter of the city as of the filing deadline
- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age
