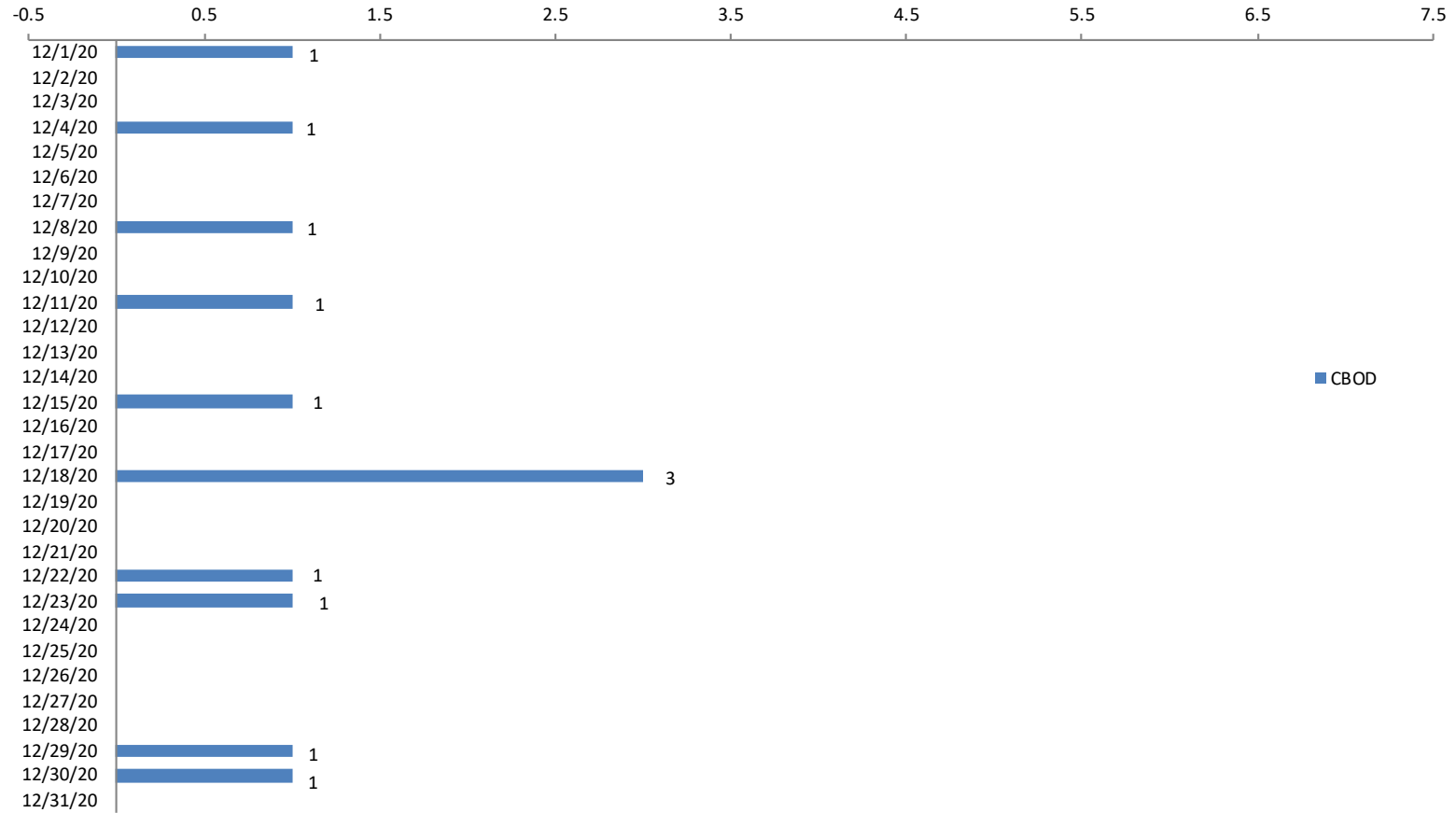


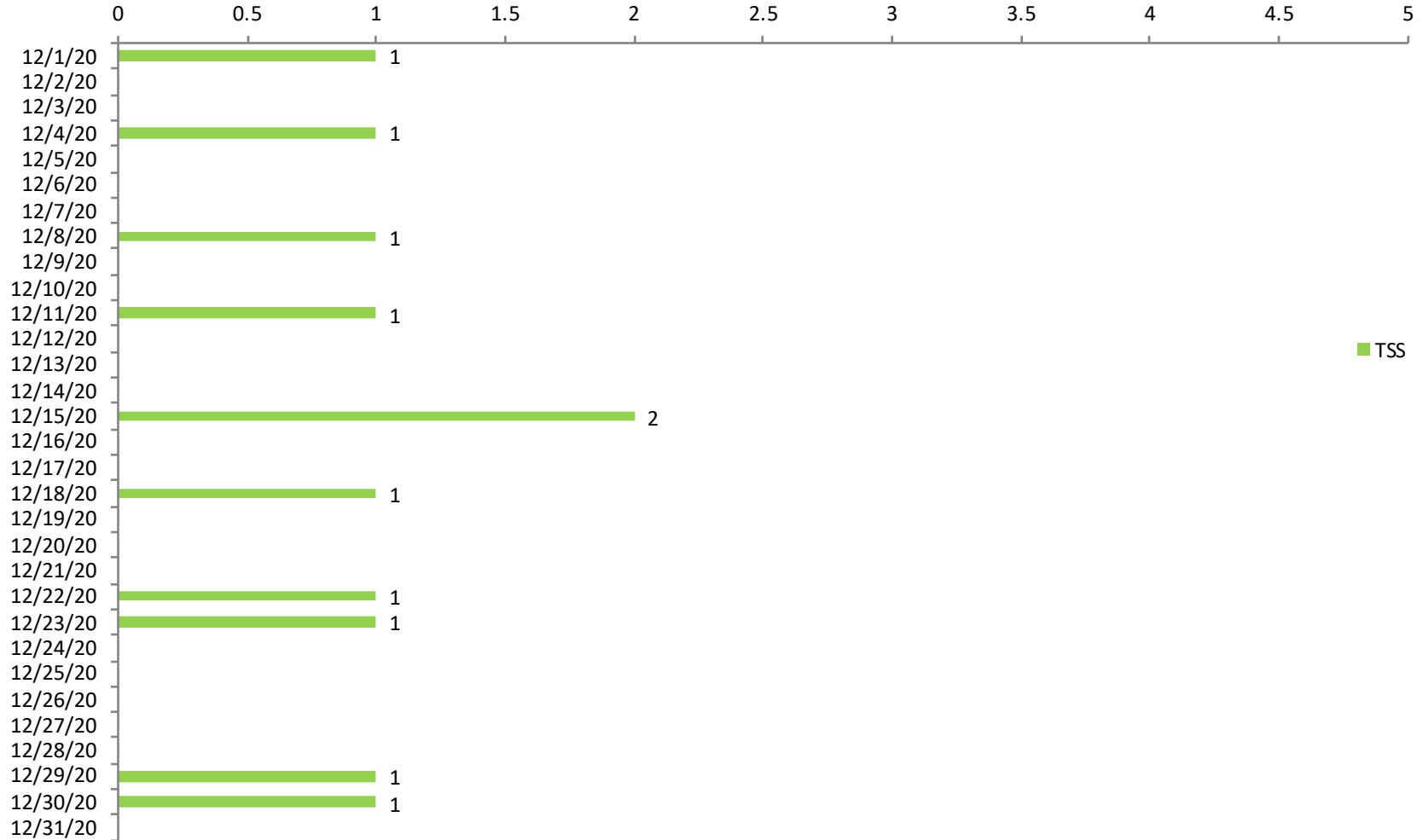
CBOD in mg/l

Carbonaceous biochemical oxygen demand or **CBOD** is a method defined test measured by the depletion of dissolved oxygen by biological organisms in a body of water in which the contribution from nitrogenous bacteria has been suppressed. South Fork permit limit on CBOD



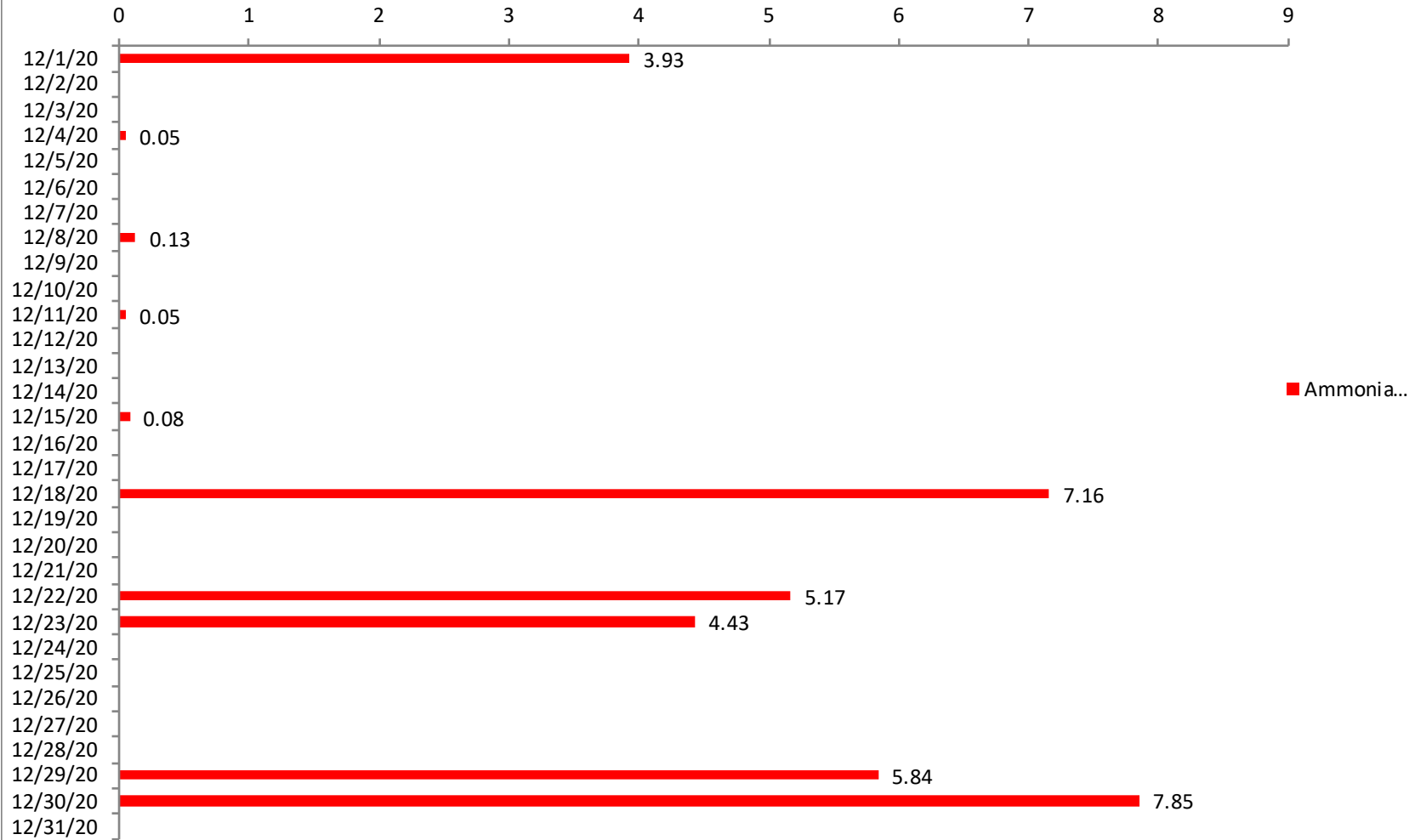
TSS in mg/l

Total Suspended Solids (TSS) is a measurement of the total solids in a water or **wastewater**



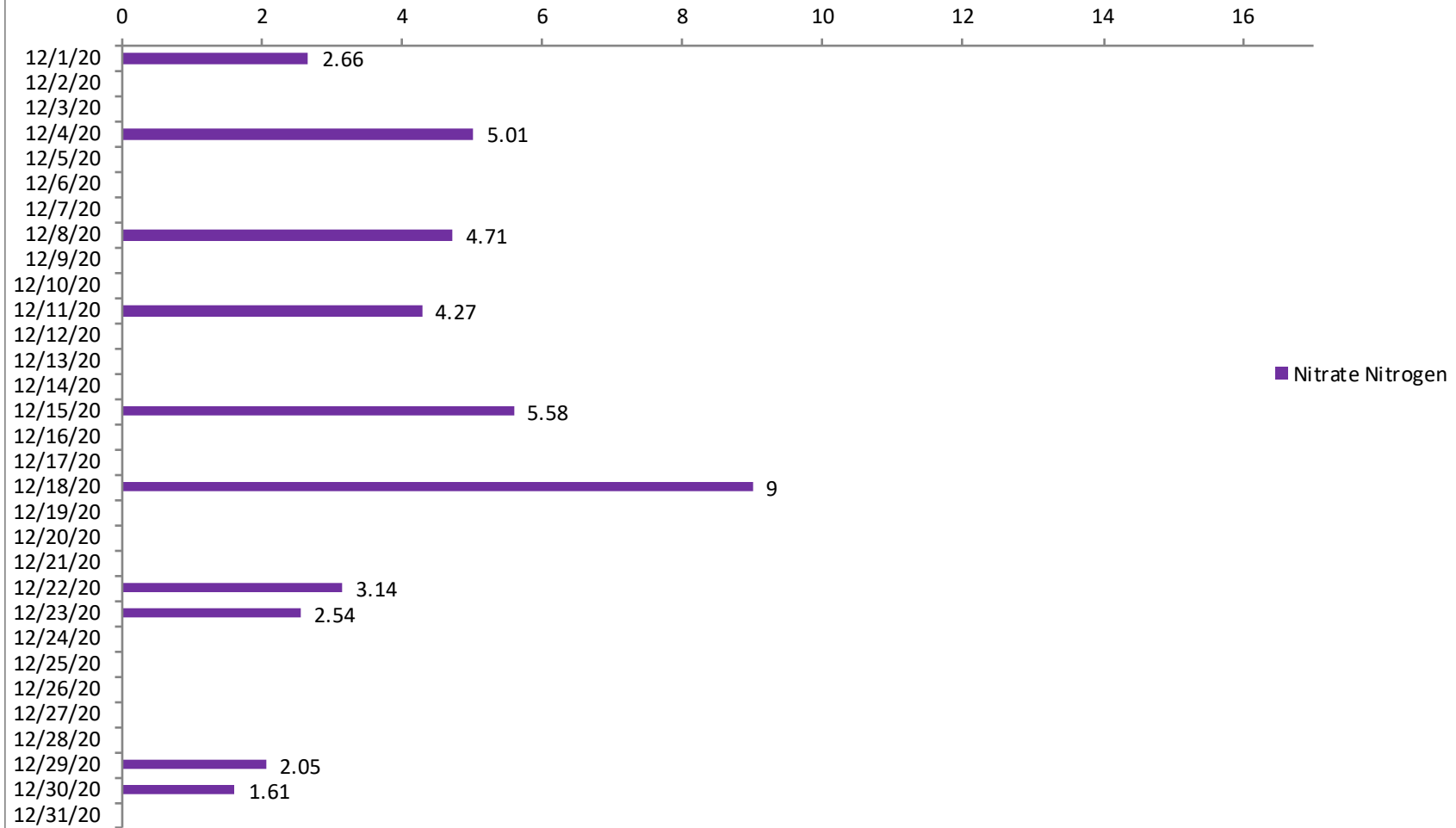
Ammonia Nitrogen in mg/l

nitrogen ammonia (NH₃-N), is a measure for the amount of ammonia found in



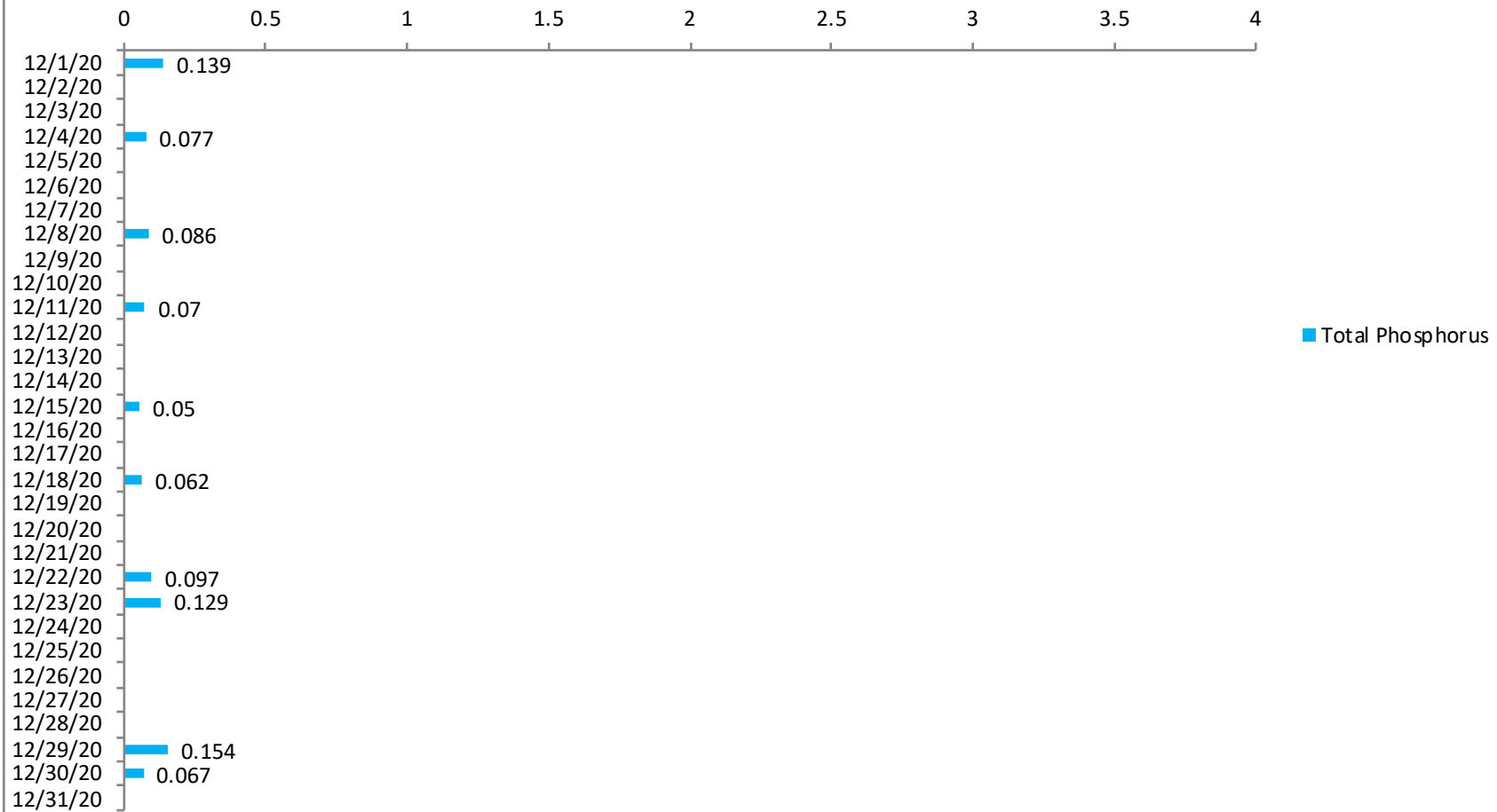
Nitrate Nitrogen in mg/l
