ORDINANCE NO 2023-O-001
*Repeal of prior and existing Purchasing
Policies*

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY HILL,
TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCES 01-O-21 AND 06-O-39
AND ANY OTHER ORDINANCES, OR ANY RESOLUTIONS,
THAT MAY EXIST CONCERNING PURCHASING
POLICIES AND/OR PROCEDURES. PROVIDING FOR
REPEALER; SEVERABILITY; EFFECTIVE DATE; AND
PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Liberty Hill (“City Council”) seeks to repeal Ordinance 01-O-21; Ordinance 06-O-39 and any other ordinances, or any resolutions, that may exist concerning purchasing policies and/or procedures.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LIBERTY HILL, TEXAS:**

1. INCORPORATION BY REFERENCE

The above premises and findings of fact are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if copied in their entirety.

2. REPEALER

To the extent reasonably possible, ordinances are to be read together in harmony. However, all ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

3. SEVERABILITY

Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections, or parts of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect an otherwise valid portion of this Ordinance.

4. PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the

time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption and it is accordingly so ordained.
