WHAT'S HAPPENING IN TOWN

During the last Community Update given by Mayor Rick Hall, one topic of discussion was implementing an Emergency Alert System for the City of Liberty Hill. Mayor Hall and City Council understand the need to provide information in emergency situations and to identify ways to expand communication with its citizens. Severe weather, boil water advisories or missing persons are simply a few reasons we need to stay connected. The City is currently reviewing three bids in order to provide the best alert service for residents during an emergency. More information will be released when a vendor has been selected. Additionally, in order to provide information on road closures or special events, the City will be using message boards as a broad communication tool.
